

SAFE MApp Tutorial 1 Video Transcript: The SAFE MApp Website, Creating an Account, and the Map App Dashboard

Thank you for choosing SAFE MApp to create your farm biosecurity or secure food supply plan maps. This tutorial will introduce the SAFE MApp website, how to create a map app account and how to use the map app dashboard.

On the website, visitors can find quick facts about using the map app, a brief video about secure food supply mapping and FAQs about premises IDs.

A premises ID is not required to create a map but can be entered and stored with it. For a secure food supply map to be reviewed, a premises ID or PIN may be required.

To create a new account, click the Create an Account link in the website navigation.

Enter into the account creation form, first and last name, email address and a password. Create a secure password that is at least 8 to 10 characters long, combining upper lowercase letters, numbers, and symbols. Do not use passwords from other application logins, birthdates, or familiar names.

Creating an account or logging in opens the map app dashboard. The top navigation menu links are for the dashboard, tutorials, and account settings. The dashboard contains a list of maps previously created or imported into an account. Click Create a Map to get started, then enter a premises 911 address. Give the map a name. The map type is Biosecurity and Safety.

And a premises ID but that can be added later.

With the exception of the map type, edit any of these details by clicking the pencil button. The newly created map will be saved automatically to the account dashboard.

The map is saved in the dashboard as a .json (or jay-son) file. This file can be exported/downloaded to a local computer and then re-import it when needed.

The .json file can be shared with other SAFE MApp account holders by email, file transfer, etc., after downloading,

However, the json file cannot be shared with other account holders within the map application.
